PROGRAM POLICIES

- These programs are available in the Spring (March–May) and again in the Fall (mid–August– November)
- There is a minimum group number of 10 students, Teachers are free, chaperones pay for meals
- Camp Y-Noah is an alcohol and tobacco free facility
- Camp Y-Noah is a nut free facility! We are able to accommodate most allergies: vegetarian, dairy free, gluten free, etc
- Youth must be monitored by adults at all times. Every group needs a chaperone/adult for each group/cabin.
- Camp-wide quiet time begins at 11 pm
- There may be other groups on camp during your stay. Please be respectful of their space and privacy. We want a fun time had by all!
- If temperatures reach 20° or below, the following activities will be cancelled: Alpine Tower, Arena Rides, Climbing Wall, High Ropes, and Trail Rides
- At the end of your stay, please make sure to pack up all of your belongings, take your trash bags out to the porch of your cabin, and sweep your cabin

CONTRACTING

How to Contract and finalize visit:

- Confirm with CYN that date and lodging is available
- Confirm classes, minimum numbers of students/chaperones/teachers
(should be 80% of what you think you will bring. You will agree to pay for this many people if less show up. We will staff and buy food for this approximate number)
- Return contract with signature and dietary form
- pay 30% non-refundable deposit Confirm schedule made by CYN staff, follow up about numbers & dietary needs at least 2 weeks before visit
- After visit: pay invoice and get on the calendar for next time!
