

Page 2: Goodie Bag Donation Each participant receives a welcome goodie bag on arrival, giving you a chance to highlight your brand with donated items!



Page 3: Upgraded Goodie Bag Donation Participants can choose an upgrade that includes a "Blind Date with a Book" and additional premium items.





Page 4: Prize Donation We'll hold various games and activities with bookish prizes.



Page 5: Activity/Program Volunteer If you or your organization has a special skill or book-related program, consider leading an activity.





Page 6: Marketing Support Books & Bonfires by becoming a marketing partner!



BOOK FAIR



The Saturday Book Fair will take place in Camp Y-Noah's Dining Hall from 2-4:30 PM. Vendors are invited to set up a booth or table to sell products and promote their organizations. Tables and chairs will be provided as needed, so all you need to bring are your items and displays! The hope is provide a "Scholastic Book Fair" Vibe for those with Adult money!

Through out the afternoon, participants will have the chance to shop, browse, and learn more about your organization.

DETAILS



Booth/Table Setup: Vendors are provided with tables and chairs to display items and materials, so all you need to bring are your products and displays. Power outlets and extension cords can be available if needed.



Audience: Attendees will browse, shop, and engage with vendors, giving your brand direct exposure to book lovers in a relaxed, personal setting. In the months leading to the retreat, CYN staff will send you updates on registration numbers so that you can best supply your table to the size of the group.



Vendor Agreement: By selecting this option, you agree to set up and staff your booth during the Book Fair hours of 2:00 - 4:30PM on March 7th in the Camp Y-Noah Dining Hall, unless other wise discussed. Vendors will need to provide their own Point of Sale (POS) System or specify cash only.





GOODIE BAG



Each participant receives a welcome goodie bag upon arrival! In this goodie bag CYN will be providing a 2026 Books & Bonfires T-Shirt, Book Mark, and sticker! A goodie bag donation will give you the chance to highlight your brand with items such as bookmarks, pencils, samples, notebooks, discount vouchers, and more!

In this upgraded goodie ga, CYN will be providing a Blind Date with a book along with any upgraded goodie bag donated items. If you or your organization has a special skill or book-related program, consider leading an activity. Options could include hosting an author reading, hosting evening activity of trivia, or guiding a book discussion.

DETAILS



Activity Setup: Vendors are provided with tables and chairs to display items and materials, so all you need to bring are your products and displays. Power outlets and extension cords can be available if needed.



Audience: Volunteering as an activity leader allows you to showcase your expertise, connect with attendees on a deeper level, and be an integral part of the retreat experience.



Vendor Agreement: By selecting this option, you agree to be available at the scheduled time(s) for your activity and to coordinate closely with our team for planning and preparation. If your activity requires payment from participants, you will need to provide their own Point of Sale (POS) or specify cash only. This will also need to be communicated to the CYN team.






MARKETING


HOW DO I SHIP ITEMS TO CAMP IN ADVANCE?
